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Our Payment Policy

It is customary for accounts to be paid in full at the time of arrangement. Alternatively, payment in full will be required **48 hours** prior to any services being performed. If you anticipate any difficulty meeting this obligation, please discuss it with your director at the time of arrangement.

Method of Payment

- Insurance Assignments (10% Charge)

Goods and Services

The goods and services shown are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only those items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically request, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the goods and services you select.

Basic Professional Services of Funeral Director and Staff **\$1,295**

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burials, forwarding or receiving remains. This fee includes the following:

- Personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to the initial call.
- Arrangement conference
- Coordinating service plans with cemetery, crematory, church, pastor, and/or other parties involved in the final service and disposition of the deceased. Does not include forms for cemeteries
- Recording the death certificate and disposition permit with the local authorities. Does not include ordering death certificates.
- This charge covers a portion of overhead, including facility maintenance, equipment and inventory cost, insurance, administration expenses, and governmental compliance.

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Preparation and care of the Deceased

Embalming \$400

Except in certain cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with a viewing. If you do not want embalming, you have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Forwarding of Remains to another funeral home \$1,995

Includes basic services, transportation of remains from the place of death (standard)

Embalming, obtaining permit, and coordinating with receiving funeral home.

Our charges exclude: Fee for other preparation of remains, shipping charge, shipping Container, any other fees that may be required for transportation to common carrier

Receiving Remains from another funeral home \$1,795

Includes basic services, transportation from Ontario Airport, custody and care of

Remains for up to 5 days, obtaining a local permit, transporting remains to a local cemetery

Or crematory. This service does not include viewing, services, or preparation of remains

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Cremation

A cremation container is required by the crematory. If you arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers must encase the body and can be made of materials such as fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are cardboard containers.

Our charge for direct cremation (without ceremony) includes: basic services, transfer of remains from place of death (within 30 miles) during normal business hours, transportation requiring one person, transportation to crematory, care of remains, necessary authorizations and documentation, 5 days of refrigeration, crematory fee, California Department of Consumer Affairs fee, and 1 permit

Note: 1 permit is required for each portion of cremated remains per California law. If you Separate cremated remains into multiple portions, you must pay for the additional Permits that are required

Burial

Direct Burial \$1,995 - \$10,365
Our direct burial includes: basic services, transfer of remains from place of death (within 30 miles)
Refrigeration up to 5 days, use of equipment and staff for immediate burial, obtaining required permit, and transportation to cemetery (within 30 miles)

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Packaged Services

Packaged service pricing is designed to ease the decision making process. The packaged prices are greatly discounted, and we cannot offer credit for deletions. Families may add items to the package for additional fees. Services over 30 mile radius will incur mileage charges.

All packages are priced at normal business hours.

Service packages do not include: Merchandise, cash advance items, or sales tax, unless stated in the package.

Pre-Need service plans are not eligible for packaged services.

In some cases, the volume of flowers may exceed the capacity of our primary vehicle for transport to the cemetery or church. As a result, families may choose to transport the excess flowers separately or take them home after the service. We offer the option to add a utility van for an additional charge.
